

in English.

Ms. White: That's right, but you can find other Japanese words. "Manga," "karaoke,"....


Haruka: Do you really use these words in English every day?

3 次は、コスタリカに住む Maki が日本の高校を訪れたときに、母親の国について話したスピーチ です。これを読んで、問1~問6に答えなさい。*印のついている語句には、本文のあとに〔注〕 があります。(32点) I am Inoue Maki. My mother is *Costa Rican. My father is Japanese. I often go to see my mother's uncle. He lives far up in the mountains. The people living there are 山の生活について not so rich, but they have very warm hearts. I have often stayed at their homes. Now I'm going to talk about their life in the mountains. The children get up before the sun rises. They *milk the cows or give food to the farm animals, and the older girls help their mothers to make breakfast and clean the house. For breakfast they have only a *molasses drink and some *corncakes/before they leave A school. ほとんどの Most children get hungry while they are at school. But they study, and try to forget bags and eat them. 1 For lunch they have black *beans, rice and bread. Around one o'clock they go back to school. Some afternoons there may be a cold *mist. Some children wear shoes with big *holes, and poorer children wear no shoes at all. Their feet *hurt, but they walk on. It is so cold, but they are happy to go to school. *Even if they don't wear any shoes or nice clothes, they sit and study all together at school. It rains hard every day during the rainy season. On the way home they *protect 73.5611 themselves from the rain with plastic sheets. べりーを持って When the children get home, they soon go out with their bags to *pick *berries 表了和电压 B 'moras' in Spanish. The berries are *dark purple. They try to pick many berries. Later they put them in plastic bags and sell them *beside the road. One day my mother and I were driving down a mountain road, and suddenly she stopped the car. 2 Then I saw a girl who was carrying 'moras' beside the road. My mother called out, "How much are they? Are they fresh?" "Forty-five *colones a bag, and I've just picked them," the girl answered. She looked happy to find my mother was going to buy a bag of berries. I found that there were many *scratches on her hands when she *handed the bag over to my mother. I looked at her hands again and the scratches looked *purplish. I asked my mother, "Why does she have so many scratches on them?" Then she answered: "When you pick 'moras', you often get scratched by the plants' *thorns. And then the juice from the berries gets into the scratches." Then I said, "Who sets the *price of the berries?" "The children decide the price themselves," she said. 13 "What do they do with the money?" I continued. "All the [to / money / them / be / their fathers / made / given / will / by], and the fathers go shopping in the next town on Saturdays," my mother answered. After some thought, I *realized that we could be happy without new cars, nice houses, beautiful clothes or good shoes. These children receive the love of their parents, and their hearts are always warm. *On the other hand, a very rich, beautiful person with a nice car and a wonderful house is *not always happy. I thought we should thank our parents even if we can't have things like nice shoes or clothes. When my mother was a child, she was such a girl. She lived in a small house, and she had to eat only bread every day. She had few clothes to wear. But she never thought she was poor, and she felt happy. 3 The important thing is how you feel. The children of the Costa Rican mountains helped me to understand this.
