



Ms. Green: I want to make good friends with my students, of course. Please try to speak to me in English. I understand Japanese, but you should use English when you're talking to me. I also want to make friends with people in Aoi-cho. So I joined the \*radio-taiso at Taiyo Park yesterday.

Sota: Oh, really?

Ms. Green: I live near Taiyo Park. From my room, I can see many people \*exercising to the music every morning. It looked interesting, so I joined them. I've already talked with some people, and they're very friendly.


